I am sending this letter to inform you that an injunction has been ordered by the Federal District Court regarding the City of Omaha Retiree Healthcare program due to the lawsuit filed by the Fire, Police and Civilian Unions and several retirees.

As a result, the City cannot process the enrollment forms that had been distributed and the insurance and premium status will remain as it was prior to the introduction of the Retiree Healthcare program. Everything is on hold until a final decision is made by the court after the trial which is scheduled for July 26, 2010.

We are holding all forms received in a separate file. We will not process any change for any covered retiree until the injunction is raised, or we receive final resolution of the court case. You will receive a follow-up letter when the case is resolved to communicate the final status of the Retiree Healthcare program.
