The Employee Assistance Program (EAP) provides free, confidential, professional assistance to help employees and their families resolve problems that may affect their personal and professional lives.

WHAT kind of problems can be taken to EAP?

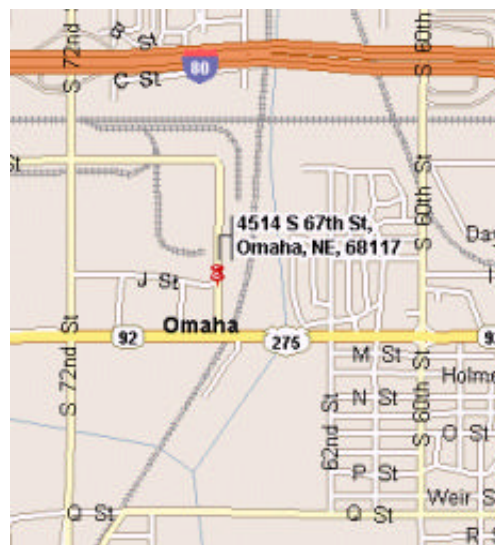

They are ready to help individuals experiencing a variety of personal problems, financial and legal worries, emotional concerns and problems caused by alcohol and drug abuse.

HOW does the EAP work?

The request for help may be made by calling **593-1711** to schedule an appointment. All Employee Assistance Program records of staff members seeking assistance will be kept confidential and will not be included in the staff member's personnel file. ***A 24-hour answering service is available nights and weekends by calling 593-1711.***
