For parents of young children we offer the convenience and assurance of on-site *Child Watch* supervision with our friendly staff. While you enjoy your workout, your kids will stay busy with games, activities, crafts, story time, and movies.

Our Child Watch Philosophy

To provide a supervised, safe, and enriching environment through non-structured, age appropriate play activities in an atmosphere of fun and enjoyment.

Three hour maximum stay; no minimum stay

Children picked up after the 3 hour time limit will be assessed a \$5.00 late fee.

Parents or guardians checking children into child watch must present a receipt or have a punch card.

Ages: 3 months – 8 years old

Policies

1. Child Watch is available to all members and guests.
2. Staff will not change diapers. A parent or guardian of the child will be found in the facility to come and change the diaper.
3. Space is limited; reservations are required for infants 3-12 months old or until walking confidently. Families of 4 or more are required to call ahead for reservations. Reservations can be made up to 48 hours in advance.
4. No shows on reservations will be charged a \$2.25 fee.
5. Only parents and legal guardians are permitted to bring children into the Child Watch area.
6. The parent who drops the child off must be the parent picking up. If someone other than the dropping off parent is picking up the child, the parent or guardian must provide written permission to the Child Watch supervisor. Proper identification must be available to ensure safety.
7. Parents and legal guardians must remain in the facility.
8. Food is not permitted in the Child Watch area.
9. Staff will not administer medicine.
10. Staff will not give a bottle to a baby or feed a child.
11. Sick children will not be allowed in Child Watch area at anytime.
12. Pacifiers and comfort items such as blankets and stuffed animals are permitted and must be labeled.
13. Common Ground reserves the right to suspend center privileges to parents who do not abide by policies and guidelines.
14. Common Ground is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Workout Interruptions

1. A child crying for more than 20 minutes
2. A child having trouble interacting with others or not following instructions from staff.
3. A child stay that exceeds the 3 hour limit.
4. A child who becomes sick.
5. A baby needs to be fed.



Management of Communicable Disease

Staff will be on alert for communicable disease and illness.

The following precautions will be taken for children suspected of having a communicable disease or illness. If a child shows any of the following signs of illness, parents or guardian will be notified immediately and the child will be asked to leave until symptoms are gone.

- Diarrhea
- Severe coughing
- Difficult or rapid breathing
- Conjunctivitis (pink eye)
- Temp of 100 degrees or more
- Unusual spots or rashes
- Vomiting
- Evidence of lice
